



RECYCLABLE MATERIALS

IT'S SIMPLE! INSTEAD OF SEPARATING RECYCLABLES BY TYPE, SIMPLY COMBINE ALL GLASS, METAL, PAPER, CARDBOARD, AND PLASTICS INTO YOUR **BROWN** CART. HERE ARE SOME HELPFUL HINTS:

DO RECYCLE

PAPER

All Clean Cardboard & Pizza Boxes
Newspapers & Inserts
Magazines, Mail & Catalogs
Wrapping Paper (Non Metallic)
Phone Books, Hard Cover Books
Paper Bags, Office Paper & Envelopes
Paper Plates (*clean*)
Milk & Juice Cartons
Drink Boxes & Aseptic Containers
Shredded Paper (put in clear bags)

PLASTIC

Water Bottles, Milk Jugs
Detergent Bottles
ALL rigid containers marked with a #1-#7 (except Styrofoam)
Large Shopping Bags marked with #2 or #4



METAL

Tin Cans, Aerosol Cans (empty)
Aluminum Cans/Foil, Pots & Pans

GLASS

All glass Bottles & Jars (all colors)
All Containers must be empty
Please do not place "trash" or yard waste in your Recycling cart. This will result in your cart not being collected

DON'T RECYCLE

Items for trash disposal:

Food Waste/household trash
Plastic Wrap
Paper Tissues, napkins, towels
Bubble Wrap
Diapers
Needles & Sharps (with proper packaging)
Envelopes that are plastic or Tyvek
Kitty litter
Regular household light bulbs (not CFL or fluorescent)
Food Plastic bags (vegetables, bread, chips)
Waxed paper/wax boxes
Packing Styrofoam or peanuts
Batteries, alkaline or button-cell

Items for the Transfer Station (Foss Rd)

Any item larger than a 5 gal bucket
Large metal (car parts, piping)
Wood/lumber, brush/leaves or grass
Plastic piping
Clothing & shoes
Knives, silverware
Toys (even if marked #6)
Vinyl siding, Construction debris
Plastic chairs, pools
Fluorescent bulbs
Electronics (computers, tv's)
Styrofoam too large to fit in your cart
