TRANSFER STATION IS FOR SACO RESIDENTS ONLY

Dump permits are attainable at the Public Works office. Permits are issued to residential property **owners** only. Owners of multi-family units will be issued 1 permit for all properties. Yardage varies by amount of units, maximum 10 yards. Contractors will be charged for all use of the transfer station without a residential permit.

PROPANE TANKS: Small green EMPTY ones can be disposed of in your household trash. Large propane tanks go to your local dealer for a fee.

ACCEPTABLE MATERIAL

White Goods fee of \$10/ea - Dishwashers, trash compactors, washers, dryers, refrigerators, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, water heaters and ovens and microwaves

CLEAN RESIDENTIAL BRUSH/LEAVES/GRASS CLIPPINGS: Clean residential brush 3" and **less** in diameter may be brought to the transfer station. Brush exceeding the annual allowance of 3 cubic yards will be charged \$6.00 per cubic yard. Leaves and grass clippings are free for residential drop off. Residents must present valid identification with current address (no P.O. Box) prior to dropping off material. Commercial users charged \$5.00 per yard.

- Stumps are accepted at CPRC GROUP in Scarborough. The current fee (January, 2009) is \$25.00 per yard.
- Permits renew July 1st of every year Automatically, you do not need to get a different card each year. If you have lost a permit, there is a \$5.00 replacement fee.
- Commercial users and Renters will have to provide identification to be allowed to dispose of materials, fees applied will have to be paid at gate
