

The City provides curbside collection of bagged (paper) leaves, once per year. Typically, the week is set up around Veteran's Day. The week can fluctuate based on weather any given year. When the week has been set, the city will post on our facebook page, advertise in the local paper and will leave a notice on our website calendar.

**What you should know about the collection:**

Bags Collected must be Paper. The City limits bags to be collected at the curb to 20 per house. If you have an excess of 20 bags, please bring those to the Transfer Station during regular operation hours. Leaves and grass is taken at the Transfer station, free of charge to residents year round. Bags must be dropped off in paper bags, or kept loose. If you arrive with plastic bags, you will be required to open and empty all bags. Also, the city does charge contractors or property maintenance companies for disposal. Any leaves or grass brought to the transfer station by a hired source will be charged \$5.00 per yard.

The City does not collect in private developments or private roads. Any bags wishing to be picked up will have to be brought out to the nearest public street in order to receive collection.

The city does not provide bags for collection. Paper Bags can be obtained at almost any local store. Shaws, Hannaford, Reny's, Home Depot, Walmart, lowes, along with many others, all will have bags available for purchase.
