

**TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING
OCTOBER 18, 2006**

The following agenda items were acted on.

1. A request to establish a handicap parking slot in Pepperell Square in front of Alphonse's Mens clothing store, on the west side of the crosswalk. Public Works Department.

2006-13 Upon Motion by Eric Cote and seconded by David Tripp to designate a disability parking slot in Pepperell Square, on the southwest side of the crosswalk located in front of Alphonse's Mens Clothing Store.

2. A request to prohibit parking too near the playgrounds around Burns School. Parks and Recreation Department.

2006-14 Upon Motion by Eric Cote and seconded by David Tripp to prohibit parking immediately abutting and adjacent to the southeast side of Burns School in the access road leading to the playground, with the exception of school buses for the purposes of loading or discharging children. The Motion passed unanimously.

2006-15 Upon Motion by Eric Cote and seconded by David Tripp to prohibit parking on the southeast side of the Burns School parking lot/school yard adjacent to the playground from the corner to a distance of 245 feet towards Summer street. The Motion passed unanimously.

2006-16 Upon Motion by Eric Cote and seconded by David Tripp to prohibit parking on the south side of the Burns School parking lot/school yard adjacent to Notre Dame School from the corner to a point 55 feet west towards Middle Street Extension. The Motion passed unanimously.

2006-17 Upon Motion by Eric Cote seconded by David Tripp to prevent vehicles from entering the Burns School parking lot/school yard from the east access road without first stopping. The Motion passed unanimously.

3. A request to prohibit parking too near the playgrounds and vehicular traffic from driving around Fairfield School. Parks and Recreation Department.

2006-18 Upon Motion by Eric Cote and seconded by David Tripp to prohibit vehicles from parking in the parking lot of Fairfield School within 20 feet of the grassy area of the playground. The Motion passed unanimously.

2006-19 Upon Motion by Eric Cote and seconded by David Tripp to prohibit access of non-emergency vehicles from parking or driving onto the access road around the north side of Fairfield School. The Motion passed unanimously.

4. A request to prohibit vehicular traffic, other than emergency vehicles, from driving around Young School. Parks & Recreation Department

2006-20 Upon Motion by Eric Cote and seconded by David Tripp to prohibit access of non-emergency vehicles from parking or driving around Young School. The Motion passed unanimously.

5. A request for a crosswalk at the Parks & Recreation Department to assist/protect kids in route to the playground at Young School. Parks & Recreation Department

2006-21 Upon Motion by Eric Cote and seconded by David Tripp to authorize a crosswalk from the south entrance to the Parks & Recreation Department, across Franklin Street to the sidewalk.
