

NOTICE TO HAULERS-6-5-03

Maine Energy has been working with Saco to reduce trucking impact in its neighborhoods. As a result of this work, a new primary route through Saco has been established as shown below. Unfortunately, because of federal regulations trucks weighing in excess of 80,000 lbs cannot use Exit 5 or Route I-195.

SACO TRUCK ROUTES-6-5-03

WASTE HAULERS WEIGHING 80,000 LBS OR LESS

Arriving Trucks.

From Scarborough or Other Points North:

- a. Exit Maine Turnpike at Exit 5:

Take I-195 to exit 2A (Route 1 South) where they will enter onto Route 1 South following said Route 1 through Saco (and that portion of Route 1 named Elm Street) to the Facility. Should the traffic condition warrant, the driver may opt to use Exit I from I-195 Spur on to Industrial Park Road to North Street, to Spring Street to Lincoln Street to Route 1 to the Facility

- b. Alternatively, take Route 1 South directly to the Facility if coming from Scarborough or points north.

From Points West of Saco:

- a. Route 5 to Spring Street, right onto Spring Street to Lincoln Street, left onto Lincoln Street, right onto Route 1 South and then to Facility; or
- b. Route 112 to Spring Street, right onto Spring Street, all the way to Lincoln Street, left onto Lincoln Street and then right onto Route 1 South and then to Facility.

Departing Trucks.

To Points North:

- a. Take Route 1 North to the I-195 Spur. From I-195, enter the Maine Turnpike. Should the traffic condition warrant, the driver may opt to use Lincoln Street to Spring Street to North Street, to Industrial Park Road, to the I-195 Spur.
- b. Alternatively, continue on Route 1 North to Scarborough and points north.

To Points West:

- a. Turn left onto Lincoln Street after crossing Saco River, and then right onto Spring Street. Trucks may then proceed one of two ways: Left onto Bradley Street/Route 5 to points in Dayton, Waterboro, Lyman, etc. but trucks must stay on Route 5 until over the Saco River; or

- b. Left onto North Street/Route 112 to points in Buxton, Gorham, etc.

To Points South:

- a. Take Route 1 North to the I-195 Spur, from I-195 enter the Maine Turnpike. Should the traffic condition warrant, the driver may opt to use Lincoln Street to Spring Street to North Street, to Industrial Park Road, to the I-195 Spur.

Packer Trucks.

- a. Packer trucks or other trash collectors may go off route within the City if they are collecting trash from a location, place, business, home in Saco and Old Orchard Beach but upon completion shall return by the most expeditious manner to an approved route.

WASTE HAULERS WEIGHING IN EXCESS OF 80,000 LBS

Arriving Trucks.

From Scarborough or Other Points North:

- a. Exit the Maine Turnpike at Exit 6 Scarborough:

Follow Route 1 South through Saco (and that portion of Route 1 named Elm Street) to the Facility.
- b. Alternatively, take Route 1 South directly to the Facility if coming from Scarborough or points north of Scarborough.

From Points West of Saco:

- a. Route 5 to Spring Street, right onto Spring Street to Lincoln Street, left onto Lincoln Street, right onto Route 1 South and then to Facility; or
- b. Route 112 to Spring Street, right onto Spring Street, all the way to Lincoln Street, left onto Lincoln Street and then right onto Route 1 South and then to Facility.

Departing Trucks.

To Points North:

- a. Take Route 1 North to Exit 6 Scarborough to enter the Main Turnpike.
- b. Alternatively, continue on Route 1 North to Scarborough and points north.

To Points West:

- a. Turn left onto Lincoln Street after crossing Saco River, and then right onto Spring Street. Trucks may then proceed one of two ways: Left onto Bradley Street/Route 5 to points in Dayton, Waterboro, Lyman, etc. but trucks must stay on Route 5 until over the Saco River; or
- b. Left onto North Street/Route 112 to points in Buxton, Gorham, etc.

To Points South:

- a. Take Route 1 North to Exit 6 Scarborough to enter the Maine Turnpike.
