## 2016 Leaf Collection

**Fall Leaf Collection will be on November 14th!**

The City of Saco will accept 20 bags curbside for leaf collection beginning November 14th! All bags must be curbside by 7:00 AM on November 14th to guarantee pickup. The leaves must be placed in paper or biodegradable bags to be picked up.

Leaves are also accepted at the Transfer Station, year-round and free-of-charge for Saco residents.

Each street will only be collected once. If you miss the curbside collection, please bring your leaves to the Transfer Station.

## NOV 14th 2016

THE CITY WILL ACCEPT **20 BAGS** CURBSIDE FOR LEAF COLLECTION BEGINNING NOV 14TH. ALL LEAVES MUST BE SET CURBSIDE BY 7:00 AM, NOV 14TH TO GUARANTEE PICKUP. THE LEAVES MUST BE PLACED IN **PAPER OR BIODEGRADABLE** BAGS.

LEAVES ARE ALSO ACCEPTED AT THE TRANSFER STATION YEAR ROUND, FREE OF CHARGE FOR SACO RESIDENTS

EACH STREET WILL ONLY BE COLLECTED ONCE. IF YOUR BAGS ARE NOT OUT ON TIME, PLEASE BRING THEM TO THE TRANSFER STATION
